

Psalm 91

- 1 *I will dwell in the secret place of the Most High
and abide under the shadow of the Almighty.*
- 2 *I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress;
My God, in Him I will trust.*
- 3 *Surely, He will deliver me from the snare of the fowler and from the
perilous pestilence.*
- 4 *He will cover me with His feathers,
And under His wings I will take refuge;
His truth will be my shield and buckler.*
- 5 *I shall not be afraid of the terror by night,
Nor of the arrow that flies by day,*
- 6 *Nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness,
Nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday.*
- 7 *A thousand may fall at my side, and ten thousand at my right hand;
But it shall not come near me.*
- 8 *Only with my eyes shall I look and see the reward of the wicked.*
- 9 *Because I have made the Lord, who is my refuge, Even the Most High,
My dwelling place,*
- 10 *No evil shall befall me, nor shall any plague come near my dwelling;*
- 11 *For He shall give His angels charge over me, to keep me in all my ways.*
- 12 *In their hands they shall bear me up, lest I dash my foot against a stone.*
- 13 *I shall tread upon the lion and the cobra,
The young lion and the serpent I will trample underfoot.*
- 14 *Because I have set my love upon You, therefore You will deliver me;
You will set me on high, because I have known Your name.*
- 15 *I will call upon You, and You will answer me;
You will be with me in trouble; You will deliver me and honor me.*
- 16 *With long life, You will satisfy me, and show me Your salvation.*
